80	Performs rough & finished interior & exterior carpentry work to construct, repair & install property (e.g., cabinets, Formica tops, play equipment, doors, shelves, desks & bulletin boards) in General Services Division & other agencies, acting as lead worker as assigned: makes building maintenance repairs & alterations; tears down old construction; builds scaffolding; remodels office; builds partitions; repairs roofs, floors, ceilings, stairs & other property as assigned; may lift, push, pull or otherwise move up to 100 lbs.; performs hand & bench work in carpentry shop; wears appropriate protective clothing (e.g., hard hat, leather apron, goggles, respirator, steel-toed shoes & cotton uniforms) to operate hand & power wood working equipment (e.g., planers, jointers, power saws & other woodworking tools & machinery); responds to systems emergency situations 24 hrs/day, 7 days/week which may require overtime or call back; may be required to wear pager &/or carry cell phone.
