%	Job Duties in Order of Importance	Knowledge, Skills & Abilities
95	Wearing appropriate protective gear (e.g., respirator coveralls, protective footwear) paints, stains, varnishes & applies vinyl to interior & exterior surfaces of building & other structures (e.g., walls, ceilings, stairwells, fixtures, furniture, signs, fences, picnic tables & equipment) with rollers, brushes & sprayers; prepares area before painting (e.g., covers areas with drop cloth; hand/power washes, scrapes, burns, & sands surfaces as needed); removes loose plaster; fills cracks & holes; mask/tapes areas; degreases or de-glosses surfaces; sets up ladder & scaffolding; moves furniture; tapes & applies finish spackling to new drywall; sands newly finished spackling; prepares walls for primer; mixes & matches paint & other surfaces coverings (e.g., varnishes, stain, tent lacquers, wood fillers, glazes); applies multi-spec paint using paint sprayer; power washes & seals concrete & pavement; operates line stripper; cleans equipment & work area; repairs defects in plaster; caulks window, doors & other areas as needed; applies putty on small defects in woodwork & furniture before repairing & refinishing; replaces broken glass in windows; hangs new vinyl wall coverings & repairs existing vinyl surfaces; utilizes advance finishing techniques (i.e., textures, plastering, historical restoration, electrostatic & airless spraying, wood finishes for furniture, doors, & molding) to repair & maintain surfaces in historical & other state buildings (i.e., Governor's residence, statehouse); mixes & applies plaster of appropriate consistency & texture for historical restoration of walls, molding & decorations; operates, cleans & maintains electrostatic & airless sprayers; restores historical wood doors & molding using appropriate techniques; operates aerial lifts to work at heights up to 100 ft.; operates motor vehicle to transport paint & equipment to job sites; performs concrete & cement work & lays bricks; caulks tubs, windows & exterior cracks; responds to systems emergency situations 24 hrs/day, 7 days/week which may require overtime or call back; required to wear pager &/or carry cell phone.
